

# A LITTLE INSPIRATION


Edson Arantes do Nascimento was born in 1940 into complete poverty. His family was so poor that he had to use a grapefruit or a sock stuffed with newspaper as a soccer ball.

Years later, he became the most successful goal-scorer in the world and was elected Athlete of the Century in 1999. In 2017, at the age of 77, he is the highest paid soccer player in the world.

"Leah, why are you talking about sports? And what the heck does this guy have to do with my music, anyway??"

Well, most people would know Edson Arantes do Nascimento as Pelé, a legend of soccer (or football, if you're in the UK), and he can teach us a lot about what it looks like to be a professional musician in the New Music Industry.

That's because he's not "just" a soccer player; he's an entrepreneur, still making millions in his seventies with endorsements and restaurants and even colognes. His most popular quote will give you some insight into his success:

But what stands out to me is "learning, studying, sacrifice . . . learning to do." He automatically assumes that anybody who wants to be successful is always learning.

I ask myself all the time, "Why are musicians so willing to spend thousands of dollars on expensive instruments and recording gear to improve their sound, but freak out at the idea of spending money to educate themselves on how to get that sound heard?!"

There are so many benefits to mastering and keeping up to date with online marketing techniques that it just has to be a priority in your life if you want to make a living as a musician. You can build a fanbase that will stick with you until you're 77 . . . or even longer! You can get your music heard by the people who want to hear it. You can make a living doing what you love. You can finance your next project, and the next, and the next . . .


## TEACHING

Teaching is great because you don't necessarily need qualifications and you can arrange your class times to suit you. You can even give lessons over Skype – that's how I take my vocal lessons.


**TAKELESSONS**
